Membership Terms and Conditions

Membership Terms and Conditions

Playing Privileges	Fees for Draw 1 must be received in full no later than October 5, 2018 or members playing privileges will be refused. Fees for Draw 2 and Draw 3 must be received before the start of those draws or members playing privileges will be refused.
Membership Period	Membership is valid for the Carleton Place Curling Club's 2018 - 2019 fiscal year ending on August 31st, 2019.
League Play	Members are eligible to curl only in leagues for which they have paid the appropriate fees. Members who wish to join other events/leagues after they paid their initial fee must pay the increased amount in order to maintain their membership in good status. Failure to pay will result in suspension until such time as the fee has been paid.
Rules of Play	All members will abide by Canadian Curling Association (CCA) and Ontario Curling Association (OCA) rules, etiquette and codes of conduct. Teams must be on the ice and ready to start their game on time.
Time Rule	The 2 hour game time clock rule applies to all 8 end games. The rule - at 30 minutes left in the 2 hour period, complete your end and play one more.
Non-Member Sparring	Non-members are limited to a maximum of 4 games per curling season at a cost of \$15 per game to be paid at the bar or placed in an envelope and deposited into the Suggestion Box next to the bar.
Returning Team Definition	A returning team is defined as the skip plus one other member OR 3 members without the skip. Returning teams are given preferred status placement in the fixed leagues.

Other Club Policies - Terms and Conditions

Liability Limitations	The Club will assume no liability for accidents, injuries or responsibility for lost or stolen articles at the club.
NSF Cheques	Any fees related to processing an NSF cheque by the bank will be PAID BY THE MEMBER
Ontario Liquor Laws	The law is to be respected at all times. No alcohol may be brought into the club.

Payment Options	Membership may be paid via cheque, cash, debit/credit or e-transfer. Split payment options are available (see Playing Privileges).

CPCCC Donations and Fund Raisers

Donations to the Friends of CPCCC may be made at any time including registration. All donations will be deposited into the Capital Expenditures account reserved for major building improvements, repairs and renovations.

In lieu of signing in and paying a loonie each week, the weekly 50/50 draws may be entered for the entire season for a donation of \$25 to the Curling Rock.

Volunteer Duties, Requirements and Obligations

New members are required to perform 4 hours of volunteer duties across the curling season.

Volunteer Opt-out donation is for members who choose not to do any volunteer duties; payable at registration.
Opt out fee: 1 game/week membership Rate \$30/draw, \$90/season Unlimited membership Rate \$40/draw, \$120/season.

Current members playing 1 game/week are required to complete 4 volunteer hours per draw or 12 hours over the course of the curling season. Volunteer deposit cheques have been discontinued for the 2018-2019 season. Members that do not complete their volunteer hours will be invoiced on a prorated basis at the end of the season. Rate \$30/draw, \$90/season

Current unlimited members are required to complete 6 volunteer hours per draw or 16 hours over the course of the curling season. Volunteer deposit cheques have been discontinued for the 2018-2019 season. Members that do not complete their volunteer hours will be invoiced on a prorated basis at the end of the season. Rate \$40/draw, \$120/season.

- (2) Any combination of daytime curling counts as one game/week. Join all daytime leagues for the price of one.
- (3) We will do our best to place you on a fixed team - no guarantees.
